## NH ENA STATE COUNCIL TRAUMA NURSING CORE COURSE November 10 & 11, 2014 7:30 am to 5:00 pm

**Course Description:** The Trauma Nursing Core Course (TNCC) is a two-day intensive course designed to provide basic level knowledge and skills associated with the delivery of professional emergency nursing care to the trauma patient in the Emergency Department. This course has been approved for eighteen (18) Contact Hours by the American Nurse's Association. The instructors have been carefully selected from professional nurses with expertise in the area of trauma care and experience in education. The TNCC is nationally recognized as the standard for nursing care of trauma patients. Successful students will receive a verification card valid for four years.

TNCC includes a didactic component each morning, and a psychomotor skill's component each afternoon. Evaluation consists of a written multiple choice exam based on the content presented in lectures and contained in the TNCC manual, as well as four psychomotor skill test stations.

**Participants:** TNCC is open to RN's only, with the recommendation that they have at least six months of clinical nursing experience in an emergency-critical care setting. The program is limited to sixteen (16) participants with preference given to those re-verifying.

**Registration:** Tuition is \$220.00 for ENA members (please enclose a copy of card) and \$300.00 for non-members. No refunds unless director notified 4 weeks prior to course. The registration deadline is **October 13, 2014. ENA** requires registration fee to confirm registration by this date. The fee includes the manual. It is strongly recommended that the manual be reviewed prior to attending the course. The manual and other course materials will be mailed directly to participants upon receipt of the registration fee, approximately four to six weeks prior to the course.

**Course Dates and Location:** Monday, November 10, and Tuesday, November 11, 2014 from 7:30 am to 5:00 pm in the Androscoggin Valley Hospital Lecture Room.
