URGENT CARE SERVICES

Don't have a doctor? Can't wait to see your PCP? Just walk in to receive expert-level healthcare for dealing with the following injuries and illnesses — no appointment necessary.

- Cough, cold, fever, sore throat
- Cuts that might need stitches
- Tick bites & Lyme disease
- Simple broken bones
- Minor infections
- Sprains or strains
- Flu symptoms
- Ear aches

What to expect at Littleton Urgent Care:

- Staffed by doctors and nurse practitioners
- Accepts most insurance plans, including Medicare and Medicaid (copays/ deductibles apply)
- Average visits are less than one hour from check-in to check-out
- Access to high-quality x-ray and laboratory services
- Access to an on-site Emergency Department led by board certified emergency medicine physicians — in case of emergency

Urgent Care: When entering the Littleton Regional Healthcare campus, turn right toward the entrance by the cafeteria.

When to seek the EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT

If there is immediate danger to life or limb, if no other option is available, and you can't wait to see your PCP, the Emergency Department is right for you.

Symptoms requiring the Emergency Department

- Chest pain
- Numbness
- Speech problems
- Shortness of breath
- Persistent vomiting
- Faintness/passing out
- Other physical symptoms that come on strongly or suddenly

Always call 911 if suffering from crushing chest pain, violent injury, heavy bleeding, or the inability to safely drive yourself to the hospital.

Emergency Care: When entering the Littleton Regional Healthcare campus, turn left toward the main entrance.
