- LRH's total annual budget for FY2021 was **\$98 Million**



LRH is a 22-year-old, 232,000 sq. ft. facility that rests in the heart of a 252-acre campus. As of September 2021, we employ over 549 dedicated professionals including more than 60 credentialed practitioners on our staff. Approximately 99% of our physicians are board-certified.

Reduce, Reuse, & Recycle facts...

- In 2021, we burned **3,737** tons of wood chips saving **\$210,513** in heating costs. LRH burned **10,075** gallons of fuel at a savings of **\$21,359**. Overall, LRH saved **\$298,287** by burning wood chips.
- **\$96,421** savings, reprocessing surgical devices with Stryker Sustainability
- **6,076** lbs. of surgical supplies recycled and kept from landfills, resulting in a savings of **\$1,823**

We provided...

- **\$1,127,686** in charity care for individuals unable to pay for services
- **338** Car Seat Safety Program checks
- **2,949** surgical procedures, including **310** joint replacements
- **26,628** diagnostic imaging exams (such as x-rays, mammograms)
- **4,602** Same Day Surgery/Endoscopy pre-admission phone calls/visits
- **\$54,539,781** in annual payroll (including salaries, employee benefits, and the services of physician specialists)
